




# WELCOME TO BUENOS AIRES CENTRE FOR INNOVATION AND CLIMATE ACTION

### A world of opportunities



In recent decades, global environmental challenges have generated growing concern about the effectiveness of existing policies and measures.

This has driven the transition to new regulatory result. approaches. As traditional a environmental objectives have been complemented, and in some cases even replaced, by market mechanisms that promote more balanced regulation based on costanalysisbenefit, optimized benefit risk management and greater flexibility for the actors involved.

While Argentina has reserved its position regarding the use of market mechanisms under Article 6 of the Paris Agreement, the private sector continues to operate in existing voluntary markets, both internationally and regionally. These markets offer a viable alternative and do not require the explicit approval of the national state, allowing private sector actors to take advantage of climate finance opportunities and contribute to emissions mitigation.

On the other hand, the sub-national governments of Argentina have confirmed their intention to move towards the creation and use of regulated carbon markets within the framework of environmental federalism.


